Horse Riding is a Dangerous Activity

I understand and acknowledge that horse riding is a dangerous activity and that horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially when frightened or hurt.

I understand and acknowledge that serious INJURY OR DEATH may result from horse riding activities and in particular this ride / lesson. I agree that I RIDE at my OWN RISK.

I agree not to drink alcohol or take drugs prohibited by law before or during this ride.

I agree I will wear a helmet when mounted on my horse, if I am under 18 years of age.

I understand that 'Cots Camp' highly recommends for adults to wear helmets when mounted on a horse, therefore I agree, if I am 18 years of age or older, and I choose NOT to wear a helmet, I do so at my **OWN RISK**.

CONDUCT

I agree to follow the directions of the ride leader/instructor and that any misconduct or refusal by me to follow any direction of the ride leader/instructor will result in the CANCELTION of my riding fee and my immediate removal from my horse, NO MATTER where that may occur.

UNDER THE FAIR TRADING ACT 1999

NOTE: The change to your rights, as set out in this form, does not apply if your death or injury is due to gross negligence on the supplier's part. "Gross Negligence" is defined in the Fair Trading (Recreational Services) Regulations 2004.
