Terms and Conditions

- **Nominations open to previous Cots Camp participants ONLY.**
- Non ACA Affiliated.
- No power on site.
- All riders under the age of 18 **MUST** wear a helmet.
- The organising committee reserves the right to change the program without notice, cancel events or apply further restrictions to first round runs should nominations exceed cattle numbers.
- Any competitor that wishes to lodge a complaint must lodge the complaint in writing to the secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$20 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the committee the \$20 is forfeited.
- Results from the weekend will be sent through to ACA.
- ALL STALLIONS must be contained as per NCCA rules.

In day light hours you may either:

A: Stallions to be double tied. Stallions to have an exclusion perimeter erected around the horse and area they are tied to exclude any possible interaction between the stallion and another horse or human.

B: Stallions to be enclosed by panels. Stallions can be free to roam inside the panel area when an exclusion perimeter is erected around the panelled area to exclude any possible interactions between the stallion and another horse or human. Only 1 horse allowed per enclosure. Panels must be a minimum of 1500mm in height. Panels must be constructed using equivalent of 4 bars of 25mm box or pipe equivalent as a minimum. Panels must be anchored securely to a solid object i.e truck, post, or tree.

At night:

The Same rules apply to daylight hours with the addition for a stallion that is in panels must have at least one additional form of restraint i.e tied up, hobbles, sideline.

- All dogs on the grounds must be either tied up or on leads at all times. No dogs permitted in the spectator's area, bar or food court.
- Nominations for all drafts must be accompanied by FULL payment, completed Equestrian Queensland Horse Health Declaration, completed Confidential Riding Application and Medical History Form, and completed Risk Warning and Waiver of Liability Form emailed to cotscamp@gmail.com or posted to Rod Cotter, PO Box 15, Widgee, QLD, 4570 **to arrive before the 19th July, 2024** or until nominations are filled, whichever is earlier.
- A 100% refund shall be given if the competitor withdraws before 8:00am of the 26th of July 2024. If the competitor withdraws after 8:00am of the 26th of July 2024, the entire amount of the nomination fee will be kept by Cots Camp. Refunds will be at the discretion of Cots Camp with each case treated on its merits.
- The judge's decision is final in all drafts.
- If Terms and Conditions are breached, your nomination/s will be terminated.


